## SUPPLEMENTAL MAPPING INFORMATION IN RESPONSE TO COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

COMES NOW, Sterling Deason O'Donnell and Darwin Deason, Co-Trustees of the Sterling Deason O'Donnell DD 2012 Trust under agreement of the DD 2014-B Grantor Retained Annuity Trust Dated September 5, 2012 ("Petitioner"), and files this Supplemental Mapping Information in Response to Commission Staff's Recommendation on Administrative Completeness in the above-referenced proceeding, and in support thereof, respectfully shows the following:

### I. BACKGROUND

On January 2, 2020, Petitioner filed a petition for expedited release to amend Marilee Special Utility District's ("Marilee SUD") water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") No. 10150 in Collin County, under Texas Water Code Section 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code Section 24.245(l), to remove Petitioner's approximately 260.372 acres of contiguous property (the "Property") from the boundaries of CCN No. 10150.

On February 3, 2020, the Commission Staff filed a Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Proposed Notice, including a memorandum from Patricia Garcia identifying certain deficiencies in the mapping content provided in the original petition (the "Memo").

On February 6, 2020, Order No. 3 was filed, finding Petitioner's application administratively incomplete, and setting February 19, 2020 as the deadline for Petitioner to cure the deficiencies described in the Memo.

#### II. SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

### **Mapping Content**

In accordance with the mapping requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code Section 24.245(m), and in response to the Memo from Patricia Garcia, Petitioner hereby submits (i) the general location map identifying only the Property, in reference to the nearest city boundary, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; (ii) a detailed map identifying only the Property, in reference to verifiable roads, attached hereto as Exhibit "B"; and (iii) digital mapping data for the Property, in shapefile (SHP) format, georeferenced in NAD83 Texas State Plane Coordinate System (US Feet), attached hereto as Exhibit "C" via CD.

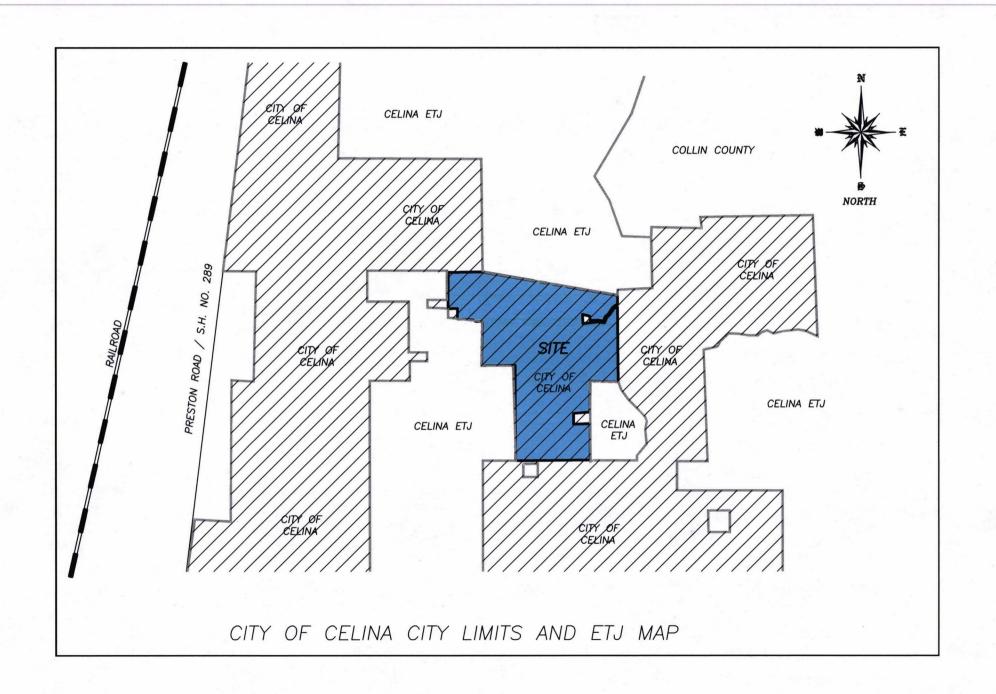

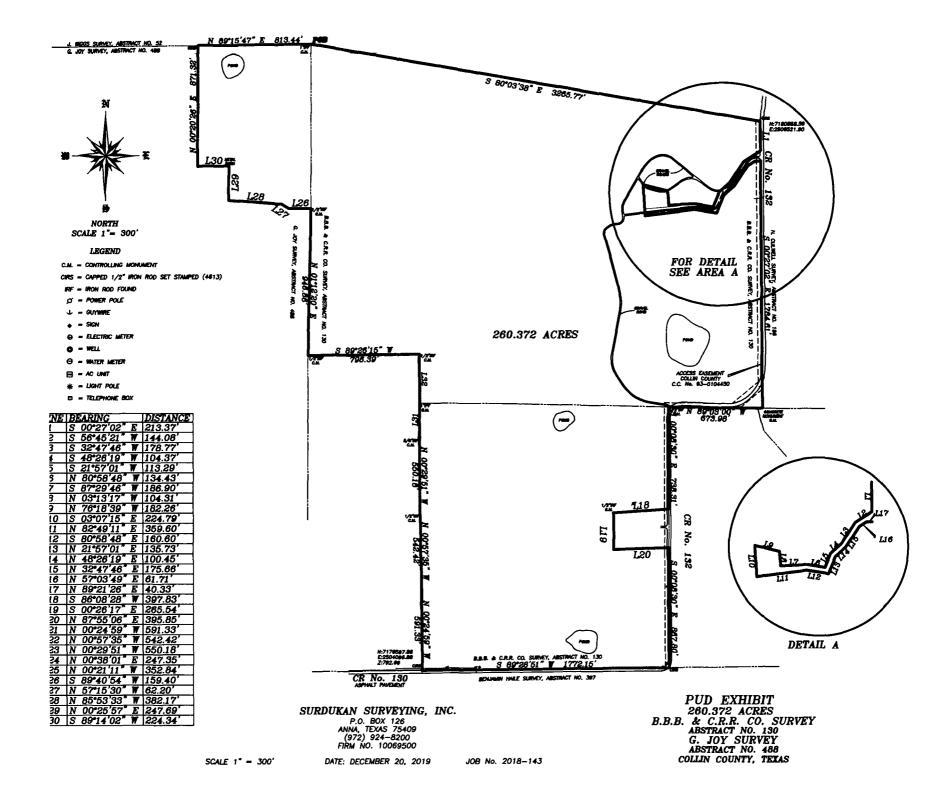
