**ORDER NO. 21  
GRANTING EXTENSION**

On October 3, 2022, Commission Staff filed a status report and requested an extension. Commission Staff has not yet secured a new appraiser to prepare a report for this docket. Commission Staff has known, since apparently sometime in August 2022, that it needs to hire a new appraiser. On September 1, 2022, Commission Staff asked for “a 30-day extension so that it may secure another appraiser to prepare its report.” In its October 3, 2022 motion, Commission Staff concedes that it still has not hired a new appraiser, and asks for an additional month to file a status report.

The administrative law judge grants an extension, but for less time than requested by Commission Staff. Specifically, Commission Staff’s appraiser’s report is due by November 3, 2022.
