ORDER NO. 3 FINDING PETITION INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the petition filed on January 2, 2020, by Sterling Deason O'Donnell and Darwin O'Donnell for expedited release from Marilee Special Utility District's water certificates of convenience and necessity in Collin County. On February 3, 2020, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review.

On or before February 19, 2020, the applicant must supplement the petition to cure the deficiencies described in Patricia Garcia's February 3, 2020, memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the petition cannot proceed.

On or before March 19, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
