## ORDER NO. 4 REQUIRING RESPONSE

This Order addresses the January 2, 2020, petition of The Sanctuary Texas, LLC for expedited release of 70.146 acres of land within the boundaries of Aqua Texas, Inc.'s water certificate of convenience and necessity number 13201 in Denton County.

On March 19, 2020, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the petition and notice. In its recommendation, Commission Staff notes that in Exhibit C-1 of the amended petition, the petitioner states that The Sanctuary granted the property to a trustee, Daniel W. Brooks.

Before a ruling on the sufficiency of the application is made, the administrative law judge directs The Sanctuary to provide, on or before April 28, 2020, an affidavit signed by Mr. Brooks, attesting that Mr. Brooks concurs with the petition for expedited release.

## I. Service

Service of pleadings is typically governed by 16 TAC § 22.74. However, in light of the Commission's Order entered in Docket No. 50664, which suspended the service requirements found in 16 TAC § 22.74, all parties must file any pleading or document with the Commission solely through the Interchange on the Commission's website and provide notice, by e-mail, to all other parties that the pleading or document has been filed with the Commission, unless otherwise ordered by the presiding officer. It will be incumbent upon all other parties to obtain a copy of the pleading or document by accessing the Interchange.
