## ORDER NO. 5 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the January 2, 2020, petition of The Sanctuary Texas, LLC for expedited release of 70.146 acres of land within the boundaries of Aqua Texas, Inc.'s water certificate of convenience and necessity number 13201 in Denton County.

On March 19, 2020, Commission Staff recommended that the petition be found administratively complete and notice be found sufficient. The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively complete and notice sufficient.

Under the provisions of Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, an order granting approval for streamlined expedited release is interim in nature, and the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.

In light of the applicability of the recent statutory amendments, the following procedural schedule applies in this case:
