AQUA TEXAS, INC.'S EXCEPTION TO PROPOSED ORDER

Aqua Texas, Inc. (Aqua) files this single exception to the Proposed Order Denying Streamlined Expedited Release filed in this matter (Proposed Order).¹ On page 2 of the Proposed Order, the sentence immediately preceding a quote from an affidavit filed by The Sanctuary Texas, LLC's (Applicant or Petitioner) says, "Aqua Texas' replies also included a notarized affidavit of Mr. McMakin attesting . . ."² In fact, the referenced reply and affidavit were filed by Applicant, not Aqua Texas.

Aqua supports the Proposed Order in all other respects and respectfully requests the Commission issue the Proposed Order as final. However, in doing so Aqua respectfully requests the Commission correct the clerical error noted above to clarify the record.


CONCLUSION AND PRAYER


