## ORDER NO. 4 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the application of Monarch Utilities 1, L.P. and Goins Utility Service LLC for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and uncertificated area in Polk County.

The administrative law judge continues to find the application incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before May 8, 2020, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the memorandum by Elisabeth English attached to Commission Staff's April 17, 2020 supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before June 8, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
