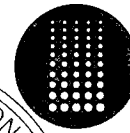
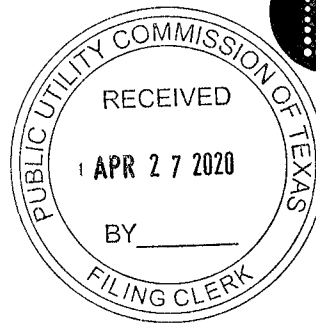

Supplemental Information to Cure Deficiencies in Response to Order No. 4

To the Commission:

Monarch Utilities I L.P. ("Monarch") and Goins Utility Service LLC ("Goins", together the "Applicants") filed an application ("Application") on January 8, 2020, requesting approval of the transfer of assets, customers, and CCN from Goins to Monarch. Goins is a small, uncertificated utility serving approximately 37 water and wastewater customers. Monarch provides service to approximately 28,600 water and wastewater customers in Texas. As detailed in Applicants' previous response to identified administrative deficiencies, filed March 10, 2020, Applicants request approval to charge Monarch's approved tariffed rates to the customers to be transferred, phased in over a period of five years to mitigate rate shock. Monarch respectfully requests expeditious review of this response and that the Application be deemed administratively sufficient so that the proposed transaction may be processed in a timely manner.

Order No. 4 issued in the above referenced docket requires the applicants to supplement the application to cure deficiencies identified by the Public Utility Commission ("Commission") Staff in a memo dated April 17, 2020. The supplemental information must be provided on or before May 8, 2010; therefore, this response is timely filed.

Staff requests the applicants supplement the application with an Appendix B for both the water and sewer financial projections and a revenue proof supporting the requested rates. Applicants' response is filed under Confidentiality, and parties have been informed following the guidelines of the Commission's Order Suspending Rules in Docket 50664.
