

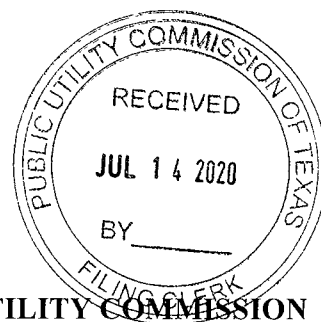

**ORDER NO. 7
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice provided Crystal Clear Special Utility District (Crystal Clear SUD) and the City of San Marcos (San Marcos) and establishes a procedural schedule for continued processing.

On June 30, 2020, the applicants filed the affidavit of Thomas P. Taggart, Direct of Public Services for San Marcos, affirming that notice was mailed on June 25, 2020 to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties. The affidavit specified each person and entity along with a copy of the map and notice. The applicants additionally provided a publisher's affidavit attesting that notice was published in the *San Marcos Daily Record*, for two weeks on June 19 and June 26, 2020.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule:

Notice completed	June 26, 2020
Deadline for intervention	July 27, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval of the sale and on the CCN amendment	August 28, 2020
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the sale	September 11, 2020
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	September 25, 2020

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120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	October 26, 2020 ¹
