

**ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE REQUIRING NOTICE,
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of Crystal Clear Special Utility District and City of San Marcos for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights and the proposed notice.


The administrative law judge finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner and form described in Elisabeth English's memorandum dated April 24, 2020. The following procedural schedule applies:

| Deadline to intervene | Thirty (30) days after notice is issued |
