



COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this response to Order No. 2, Commission Staff's Recommendation on Administrative Completeness. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On January 27, 2020, River Oaks Ranch Water System (Applicant) filed a petition to discontinue water service and cancel the associated exempt utility registration No. N0069 in Bandera County. The Applicant asserts there is no charge for the provision of water service in the area which includes approximately 81 acres and no customers.

On January 28, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 1 requiring Staff to file a recommendation regarding how this petition should be processed and propose a procedural schedule by February 26, 2020. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMNISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the application, and as supported by the attached memoranda of Patricia Garcia, Engineering Specialist of the Commission's Infrastructure Division, Staff has concluded that the application contains all necessary information to be deemed sufficient for filing and administratively complete. Staff recommends that notice is not necessary in this docket as there are no customers being served by the Applicant.

III. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes a deadline of March 26, 2020 to file a final recommendation.
