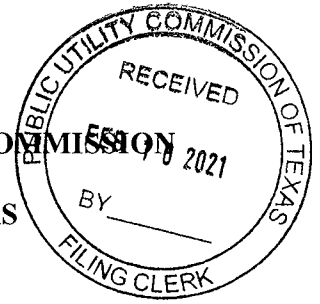

COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

On January 30, 2020, Kenneth V. Land (Mr. Land) and Greg Coburn (Mr. Coburn) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger STM of an exempt utility and associated registration number N0063. The application was originally filed under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239. In the application, Mr. Land indicated that he intended to transfer his exempt utility and the associated registration to the current landowner, Mr. Coburn. The application includes a warranty deed filed with Comal County and states that no compensation has been exchanged.

On December 15, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 9, setting a February 16, 2021 deadline for the Public Utility Commission of Texas Staff (Staff) to file a recommendation on final disposition or to request a hearing. Staff now alternatively files this extension request.

I. REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff is continuing to prepare a final recommendation; however, because of delays caused by the February 2021 winter storm, Staff needs additional time to finalize its recommendation. Staff would therefore respectfully request a 10-day extension to allow for sufficient time for Staff to review and finalize its recommendation.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with Staff's request for a 10-day extension.
