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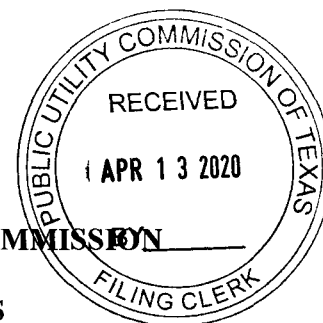

**APPLICATION OF KELLY G.

**COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION
ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS**

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 2, files this Recommendation on Administrative Completeness. Staff recommends that the application be deemed insufficient for further review. In support, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 14, 2020, Kelly G. Brewer (K. Brewer) filed an application for an annual rate adjustment under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.1872.

On February 25, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 2, directing K. Brewer to submit additional materials on or before March 20, 2020 and requiring Staff to file a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and notice by April 10, 2020.¹ Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff filed a letter setting out the deficiencies in the application on February 24, 2020. To date, K. Brewer has not responded. Therefore, Staff recommends that the application be deemed insufficient for further review.

III. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends that the application remains administratively incomplete. Staff therefore recommends that a deadline of May 11, 2020, be established for K. Brewer to file a response to Staff's letter of February 24, 2020. Staff further recommends that a deadline of June 10, 2020 be

established for Staff to review K. Brewer's supplemental filing and make a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff recommends that the application be found administratively incomplete. Staff further recommends that the procedural schedule proposed above be adopted for further processing of this docket.
