**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application filed on February 14, 2020, by County Line Special Utility District to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity and to decertify a portion of Polonia Water Supply Corporation's certificate of convenience and necessity in Hays and Caldwell counties. On April 17, 2020, and June 16, 2020, County Line SUD filed supplements to the application.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively complete and directs County Line SUD to provide notice of the application as described in the July 15, 2020 memorandum of Jolie Mathis, using the included forms.

The following procedural schedule applies:

Event	Date
Deadline for County Line SUD to file with the Commission signed affidavits that notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	August 31, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	September 14, 2020
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
