**COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND
MOTION FOR AN AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Second Request for Extension of Time and Motion for an Amended Procedural Schedule. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 14, 2020, County Line Special Utility District (County Line SUD) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10292 and to decertify a portion of Polonia Water Supply Corporation's water CCN No. 10420 in Hays and Caldwell Counties under Texas Water Code (TWC) §§ 13.242 to 13.250 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.225 to 24.237. The requested service area consists of 425 acres and no existing customer connections. County Line SUD filed supplemental information on April 17, 2020 and June 16, 2020.

On October 12, 2020, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 6 requiring Staff to file a final recommendation on the application by November 13, 2020. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME & MOTION FOR AMENDED PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE**

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff needs more time to obtain the required consent

forms and review the application. Therefore, Staff requests an extension of its deadline to file a final recommendation on the application and that the remaining deadlines in the procedural schedule be adjusted accordingly. As such, Staff proposes to amend the procedural schedule as follows:

Event	Date
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the Application	December 1, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	December 18, 2020

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order granting the requested extension of time and adopting the amended procedural schedule outlined above.
