## ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the application of County Line Special Utility District filed on February 14, 2020, to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10292 and to decertify a portion of Polonia Water Supply Corporation's CCN number 10420 in Hays and Caldwell counties.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before April 16, 2020, County Line SUD must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in the memorandum of Elisabeth English dated March 16, 2020. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before May 15, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
