Dear Customers,

On March 16, 2020, Corix Utilities (Texas), Inc. ("CUTX") filed a request with the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("PUCT") and other regulators to increase water and wastewater rates for its Texas customers. Concurrent with its March 16, 2020 filing, the Company sent all of its affected customers a notice letter explaining its rate increase and how customers may participate in this proceeding. Since filing its rate request, the Company has conferred with the PUCT Staff to address certain issues that needed to be corrected or clarified in its original application and notice letter. Accordingly, the Company is providing customers this updated notice of its proposed changes in rates.

Since our last rate request, we have made significant investments in our systems and have also experienced increased operations and maintenance expenses due to higher testing and chemical costs, increased maintenance activities, higher labor costs, and increased regulatory compliance costs. Because our current rates do not accurately reflect our <u>actual costs</u> to provide service, the requested increase is necessary at this time.

CUTX's rates are subject to the approval of the PUCT. We have requested that rates take effect for all customers on October 21, 2020, which is 35 days after the submission of this updated notice. However, no change in rates will take effect until it is approved by the applicable regulatory authority. The attached "Customer Notice" provides further information about this filing, including a description of the change in rates, instructions on how to review the entire application and how to protest the proposed rate change.

While we understand that there is never a good time to raise rates, this increase is necessary to allow us to continue to meet our shared goals of providing outstanding wastewater service and safe and reliable drinking water delivered to your taps. It also ensures safe working conditions for our staff and continued prudent business practices.
