**ORDER NO. 10  
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice of the February 18, 2020 application by the City of Alton to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Hidalgo County and establishes a procedural schedule.

Alton filed proof of completed notice on October 5, 2020, October 9, 2020, December 1, 2020, and February 3, 2021.

On February 22, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for further processing of the application:

Deadline to intervene	March 5, 2021
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to applicant for review and consent	April 9, 2021
Deadline for applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	April 23, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	May 7, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	May 21, 2021
