We have received the first request for information dated March 3, 2021 and have included the information as an attachment to this letter. Additionally, please see below for our responses to individual comments.

Commission Staff's First Request for information to the City of Alton

Staff 1-1

1. Attached is detailed map identifying all existing lines and customers with color coded parcels using the requested categories. Excel table is also included in electronic submittal.

Staff 1-2

1. Attached in excel table is written explanation for each parcel. Requested area has been revise to better justify the ability to serve the requested areas for future developments.

Staff 1-3

1. There are currently 246 existing connections within the requested service area. There are an additional 131 onsite sewer facilities within the highlighted areas.

Staff 1-4

1. In addition to new service request driven by growth in development, within the requested area there are existing designated disadvantage communities in need of first-time service. Historically, the City of Alton has aggressively pursued public funding to extend service to these areas.

Staff 1-5

1. The developer requests are only for a portion of the requested CCN.

Staff 1-6

1. Acreages are shown in the attached table for each of the category requested.

Staff 1-7

1. Detailed map showing the requested CCN in relation to the existing City Limit and ETJ included in re-submittal.

Staff 1-8

1. Expansion has been driven by private development and therefore funded by these developments. It is the intent of the City of Alton to develop additional public lines to take advantage of this growth and provide service to areas in need.



Staff 1-9

1. Growth into the requested area is driven by private development and therefore funded by private development sources. In 2012 the City of Alton applied for assistance through the Texas Water Development Board and was awarded 9.5 Million through the Clean Water State Revolving fund to provide first time service to disadvantage areas. If the expansion request is approved, current applications with the state would rate higher if the city is the owner of the CCN.
