COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON AMENDED MAPS

On February 18, 2020, the City of Alton (Alton) filed an application to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20809 in Hidalgo County. The requested area consists of 1,434 total acres and 76 customer connections.

On November 4, 2021, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 16, amending the procedural schedule, and requiring Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a supplemental recommendation on the amended maps by December 22, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. RECOMMENDATION ON AMENDED MAPS

As of December 22, 2021, Alton has not filed amended maps in this proceeding as required by Order No. 16. Therefore, Commission Staff cannot make a recommendation on amended maps. Commission Staff recommends that Alton filed amended maps based on the identified deficiencies in the memorandum of Patricia Garcia of the Commission's Infrastructure Division attached to Commission Staff's November 2, 2021 recommendation.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Commission Staff proposes the following procedural schedule in accordance with the above recommendations.
