ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE; AND SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE

This Order addresses the March 9, 2020, application filed by MSEC Waste Water, Inc. to change rates. On April 15, 2020, Commission Staff filed comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice.

The Commission finds the application incomplete and deficient. The Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before May 6, 2020, MSEC must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the April 15, 2020 memoranda from Debi Loockerman. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. MSEC may not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

On or before May 27, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.

Under Texas Water Code § 13.1871(e) and Texas Administrative Code § 24.1(b), the effective date of the proposed rate change is suspended until a properly completed application is accepted.
