Please admit or deny that the Master Service Agreement between Mid-South Electric Cooperative Association, d/b/a MidSouth Electric Co-op or Mid-South Synergy and MSEC Enterprises, Inc. allows the parent company to exercise control over the operations, management decisions, or policies of MSEC Enterprises, Inc. directly or through an intermediary. If deny, please explain why the Master Service Agreement does not allow Mid-South Electric Cooperative Association, d/b/a MidSouth Electric Co-op or Mid-South Synergy to exercise control over the operations, management decisions, or policies of MSEC Enterprises, Inc. directly or through an intermediary.

RESPONSE: Deny.

MSEC WW disputes the relevancy of contractual agreements between MidSouth Electric Cooperative and MSEC Enterprises, Inc., to the rate application filed by MSEC WW. Also, MSEC WW is not a party to the Master Service Agreement referenced in Staff 1-4.

However, the Master Service Agreement referenced in Staff 1-4 clearly sets out the services to be provided by MidSouth Electric Co-op (MidSouth) to MSEC Enterprises, Inc. All of the services provided by MidSouth to MSEC Enterprises, Inc. are as directed by MSEC Enterprises, Inc. There is nothing in this agreement that suggests that MidSouth exercises any control over the decisions made by MSEC Enterprises, Inc. or its policies. In fact, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. does not, at any time, relinquish its control over the operations, management decisions, or policies of MSEC Enterprises, Inc. to MidSouth, MSEC Waste Water, Inc., any other subsidiary of MidSouth, or any third-party entity.

Specifically, the Master Service Agreement provides as follows:

- Paragraph I.A.: The Cooperative shall perform "all administrative services *required by Enterprises* in the ordinary course of Enterprises' business."
- Paragraph I.B.: The Cooperative shall provide "all customer service and billing customer accounts *required and requested by Enterprises* in the ordinary course of Enterprises' business."
- Paragraph I.C.: The Cooperative shall provide "all transportation service required and requested by Enterprises in the ordinary course of Enterprises' business."
- Paragraph I.D.: The Cooperative shall provide "such office space, on-site storage, parking facilities, and general access . . . required by Enterprises in the ordinary course of Enterprises' business."
- Paragraph I.E.: The Cooperative shall provide "all goods, tools, equipment, and supplies required and requested by Enterprises in the ordinary course of Enterprises' business."

Mr. Kelton serves in two distinct and separate capacities.

Mr. Kelton signed the Master Service Agreement as the General Manager/CEO of Mid-South Electric Cooperative Association, d/b/a MidSouth Electric Co-op.

Mr. Kelton also signed the Master Service Agreement in his capacity as President/CEO of MSEC Waste Water, Inc.
