**ORDER NO. 10
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING
OPPORTUNITY TO CURE; AND SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Order addresses the March 9, 2020, application filed by MSEC Waste Water, Inc. to change rates. On November 6, 2020, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness of the application and notice.

The Commission finds the application incomplete and deficient. The Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before November 30, 2020, MSEC must amend its application and provide the information required in the memorandums of Leila Guerrero, Stephen Mendoza, and Emily Sears, of the Commission’s Rate Regulation Division, and Roshan Pokhrel, of the Commission’s Infrastructure Division, filed on November 6, 2020. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. MSEC may not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

However, it appears to the ALJ that the forms 1096 and 1099 have been submitted by MSEC. By November 24th, Staff will provide comment on why these submissions are insufficient or amend its memorandum.

On or before December 21, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.

Under Texas Water Code § 13.1871(e) and Texas Administrative Code § 24.1(b), the effective date of the proposed rate change is suspended until a properly completed application is accepted.
