**ORDER NO. 12**  
**FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the application of MSEC Waste Water, Inc. for a rate change for its sewer customers. On January 22, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on notice sufficiency and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice sufficient. The effective date of the rate change remains suspended as ordered in Order No. 11.

The procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted as follows:

<b>Event</b>	<b>Date</b>
Proposed effective date of rate change	February 25, 2021
Deadline to intervene, comment, or request a hearing (90 days from the proposed effective date of December 1, 2020). <sup>1</sup>	May 26, 2021
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on final disposition	June 2, 2021
Deadline for applicant to respond to Commission Staff's recommendation or, if no disputed issues exist, deadline for parties to file proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs.	June 9, 2021
Deadline for the Commission to set the matter for a hearing on its own motion (120th day after the effective date) <sup>2</sup>	June 25, 2021

<sup>1</sup> Under 16 TAC § 24.35(c)(2), if during the first 90 days after the effective date of the rate change, the Commission receives a complaint from any affected municipality, or protests from the lesser of 1,000 or 10% of the ratepayers of the utility over whose rates the Commission has original jurisdiction, the Commission will set the matter for hearing.
