# COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On March 9, 2020, MSEC Waste Water, Inc. (MSEC) filed as a Class D utility using a Class C rate change application for its sewer customers. MSEC holds sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20984 with a total of 10 active connections.

On January 28, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 12 requiring the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to request a hearing or file a recommendation on final disposition on or before June 2, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

#### I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time review the discovery responses filed on May 3 and 4, 2021, and to finalize its final recommendation. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline to file its final recommendation or request a hearing be extended to June 18, 2021.

### II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the issuance of an order extending the deadline for Staff to file its final recommendation or request a hearing to June 18, 2021.
