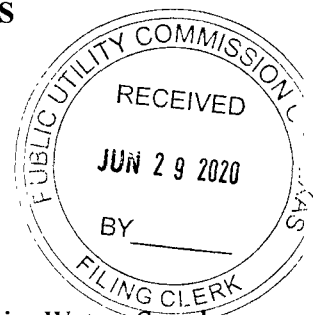

**ORDER NO. 5**  
**FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND**  
**ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**



This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice provided by Polonia Water Supply Corporation and the City of Lochart and establishes a procedural schedule for continued processing.

On June 15, 2020, the applicants filed an affidavit indicating that notice of the application was mailed to cities, districts, neighboring retail public utilities, the county judge, affected customers, and affected parties on May 29, 2020. The filing also included the publisher's affidavit showing that notice was published in the *Lockhart Post-Register*, a newspaper generally circulated in Caldwell county on June 4 and 11, 2020.

On June 25, 2020, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on sufficiency of notice and proposed procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule:

<b>Event</b>	<b>Date</b>
Notice completed	May 29, 2020
Deadline for intervention	July 11, 2020 <sup>1</sup>
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval of the sale	July 29, 2020
Deadline for applicants to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation or request a hearing	August 28, 2020

<sup>1</sup> The final notice was published on June 11, 2020. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239(b), the intervention period shall not be less than 30 days.

If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and transaction to proceed	September 11, 2020
120-day deadline to approve the sale or require a hearing	October 9, 2020 <sup>2</sup>
