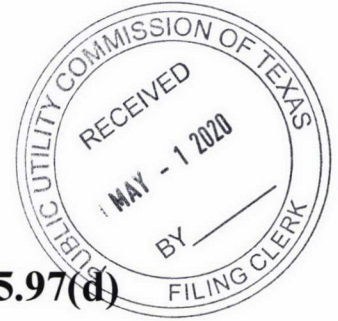

1. Provide a summary description of hazard recognition training documents you provide your employees related to overhead transmission and distribution facilities.

Lone Star Transmission, LLC (Lone Star) provides the following hazard recognition training to employees related to overhead transmission facilities. Lone Star does not own distribution facilities.

Training on Hazard Recognition Related to Overhead Transmission Facilities: Lone Star trains its field employees regarding the effects of electrical shock; high-risk equipment and activities; Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) standards related to electrical hazards; rules concerning activities near power lines; and hazard recognition, correction, and documentation.

Regular Internal Safety Meetings: Lone Star conducts regular monthly safety meetings for all employees and for field employees, emphasizing the importance of safety and hazard recognition and providing a forum for employees to identify safety concerns or potential hazards.

2. Provide a summary description of training programs you provide your employees related to the National Electrical Safety Code for construction of electric transmission and distribution lines.

Lone Star provides the following training to employees related to the National Electrical Safety Code (NESC) for the construction of overhead transmission facilities. Lone Star does not own and does not plan to construct distribution facilities.

Training on NESC: Lone Star's NESC training includes specific information regarding NESC electrical clearance requirements. The NESC training identifies: the purpose of the NESC; specific clearance and spacing requirements identified in NESC rules; the required grade of construction of lake crossings; conductor loading requirements that may affect line sag and tension; NESC lake crossing clearance requirements; and additional lake crossing clearance requirements (e.g., clearance requirements specified in United States Army Corps of Engineers easements and Texas Department of Transportation road crossing agreements). The NESC training also explains that NESC vertical clearance requirements must be maintained under all expected operating conditions.

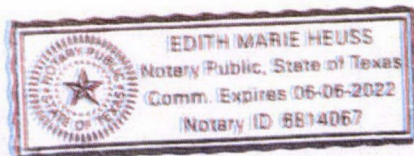
