1. Provide a summary description of hazard recognition training documents you provide your employees related to overhead transmission and distribution facilities.


Rayburn Country Electric Cooperative (RCEC) has a hazard recognition training plan as required by OSHA. The American Public Power Association (APPA) Safety Manual is the standard resource provided to each employee. The APPA manual covers a wide variety of topics for electric facilities, including employee responsibility for safety and reporting of hazardous conditions.

2. Provide a summary description of training programs you provide your employees related to the National Electrical Safety Code for construction of electric transmission and distribution lines.

RCEC has licensed Professional Engineers provide training to applicable employees on required clearances between energized conductors and various possible situations as formulated by the National Electrical Safety Code. The use of examples and illustrations reinforces the concepts, and the open dialogue forum allows for questions and answers to be exchanged in an informative manner. RCEC has partnered with Northwest Lineman College to establish a Lineman Apprenticeship program that uses their curriculum to train and certify Apprentice Linemen in all applicable industry standards regarding Safety requirements and utility best practices.


