ORDER NO. 4 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses administrative completeness of the application of Windsor Water Company, filed on February 27, 2020, and supplemented on April 6, 2020, for a Class D annual rate adjustment. In Order No. 3 filed on June 2, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) required Windsor to file supplemental information by June 29, 2020. To date, Windsor has not filed any supplemental information in response to Order No. 3. On July 29, 2020, Commission Staff filed a recommendation that the application be found deficient and that Windsor Water have the opportunity to cure the deficiencies.

The ALJ finds the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before August 27, 2020, Windsor Water must file the supplemental information to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff in its supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness filed on May 29, 2020. On or before September 28, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the application and notice, and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
