



ORDER NO. 2 GRANTING EXTENSION AND ORDERING ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FROM THE APPLICANT

This Order addresses Commission Staff's March 27, 2020, request for extension of the deadline to file administrative comments on the application and notice. Commission Staff requests the extension to allow for additional time to further analyze the application and to allow the administrative law judge (ALJ) time to rule on the motion to consolidate filed in Docket No. 50618.¹

The ALJ grants Commission Staff's request for extension. On or before April 13, 2020, Commission Staff must file comments on the sufficiency of the application and notice.

Additionally, in Order No. 1 filed on March 11, 2020, the ALJ ordered Simply Aquatics to, by March 23, 2020, state the total number of water connections it serves. It is unclear whether Simply Aquatics has done so. Accordingly, the ALJ orders as follows: by April 14, 2020, Simply Aquatics must file a document with the Commission stating the total number of connections Simply Aquatics serves under certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 13259, including but not limited to all connections in the La Playa, El Pinion, Vista Verde, and Timberlane subdivisions.
