**ORDER NO. 4
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Quadvest, L.P.'s March 6, 2020 application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 11612 and sewer CCN number 20952 and to decertify portions of the City of Conroe's water CCN number 10339 and sewer CCN number 20135 in Montgomery County, Texas. Quadvest filed supplements to the application on May 18 and 27, and July 23, 2020. On June 29, 2020, the City of Conroe filed a letter consenting to Quadvest's application. On August 3, 2020, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the application.

The administrative law judge finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs Quadvest to provide notice of the application as described in the August 3, 2020 memorandum of Roshan Pokhrel, using the forms attached to Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed notice.

The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	September 25, 2020
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
