COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On March 6, 2020, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Montgomery County. The application also seeks to decertify portions of the City of Conroe's (Conroe) water CCN No. 10339 and sewer CCN No. 20135. The requested service area consists of approximately 257 acres and no current customer connections.

On January 19, 2021, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 8, requiring the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) and Quadvest to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law by February 19, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff and Qaudvest need additional time to prepare the joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending the deadline for the parties to file the joint pleading to February 26, 2021.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order granting the requested extension of time.
