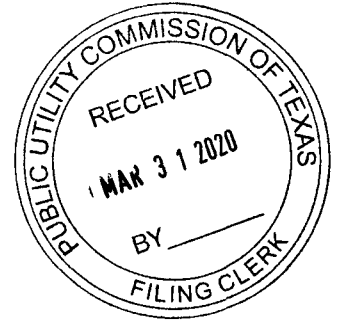

Phoenix Wind Repower (Phoenix) appreciates the close attention and quick response the Commission has been giving to the COVID-19 pandemic. Phoenix is continuing to monitor updates from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention regarding the COVID-19 pandemic and is following guidance from local, state, and national officials to ensure the safety of all personnel. The Phoenix sites consist of the wind farms listed above. These sites are currently operational and undergoing a repowering effort, with concurrent operations and construction at all three sites.

With circumstances evolving quickly, we believe it is vital to keep others informed of the measures Phoenix and our partners have enacted among our operations and construction teams to minimize the risk of personnel exposure and continue to maintain business continuity. In addition to enhanced sanitation measures and social distancing practices and in accordance with all state and local policies, our team has implemented robust changes, including the following:

- The off-site operations control center has been mobilized remotely with all operators working from home.
- Key Site Managers are working remotely whenever possible with site access only for necessary hands-on activities.
- Access to the O&M buildings have been restricted and all packages are dropped off outside the building.
- Turbine Technicians are divided into teams and have segregated activities from the other teams.
- Any construction personnel that need to enter the O&M Building must schedule ahead and be checked for symptoms.
- Enhanced cleaning is being conducted in the O&M building and all construction trailers.
- All site meetings are conducted remotely via web technology. Office trailers are restricted to essential personnel only and closed to visitors and construction crews.
- Rigorous hygiene practices, including proper hand-washing techniques, the avoidance of shaking hands, and sanitization of work surfaces, are continuously reinforced. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes are readily available throughout the site.
- In addition to the standard personal protective equipment (PPE), construction site safety personnel have been provided with disposable gloves for handling of packages and exchanging any equipment/tools between teams.
- Workers are assessed upon reporting to the site to confirm that they are fit for work. Assessments include the evaluation of COVID-19 symptoms .
- Any employees with symptoms will not be allowed on site and will require a 14-day quarantine and/or a return-to-work authorization from a medical provider before returning to work.

Leadership is closely monitoring federal, state, and local guidance and will continue to update our procedures to maintain alignment with shifting recommendations as the situation continues to evolve.
