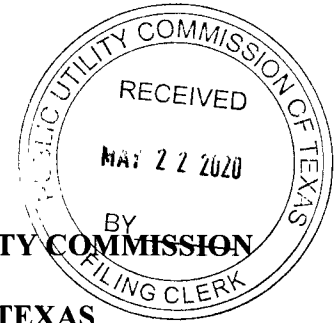

**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of Utilities Investment Company, Inc. (UIC) to amend its water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity in Liberty County.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before June 26, 2020, UIC must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Jolie Mathis' May 12, 2020 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before July 24, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
