**NOTICE OF APPROVAL**

This Notice of Approval addresses the March 31, 2020, tariff filing by AEP Texas Inc. in compliance with an order entered in Project No. 50664.<sup>1</sup> AEP Texas seeks to implement AEP Texas – Central Division, Schedule 6.1.1.4.12 Rider ERP—Covid19 Electricity Relief Program Fund, Original Page 1 and AEP Texas – North Division, Schedule 6.1.1.4.12 Rider ERP—Covid19 Electricity Relief Program Fund, Original Page 1. AEP Texas requests an effective date of April 1, 2020.

In accordance PURA<sup>2</sup> § 36.104, the Commission is permitted to implement an effective date of a change in rates, other than a major change, before the 35-day period prescribed in PURA § 36.102 for good cause.

The proposed tariff submitted by AEP Texas is consistent with the directive from the Commission in the Order Related to Covid-19 Electricity Relief Program filed in Project No. 50664. For this reason, the administrative law judge approves AEP Texas's AEP Texas – Central Division, Schedule 6.1.1.4.12 Rider ERP—Covid19 Electricity Relief Program Fund, Original Page 1 and AEP Texas – North Division, Schedule 6.1.1.4.12 Rider ERP—Covid19 Electricity Relief Program Fund, Original Page 1, effective April 1, 2020.

The Commission's Central Records Division must mark, as *Approved*, AEP Texas' tariff sheets, attached to this Notice of Approval, effective April 1, 2020, and place them in the Commission's tariff book.

##### **MONTHLY RATE**

A Retail Customer's COVID-19 Electricity Relief Program (ERP) Fund fee for the billing month shall be determined by multiplying the appropriate ERP fund charge factor, shown below, by the current month's billing kWh, as determined in the Retail Customer's applicable Rate Schedule.

The amount to be billed is determined by multiplying the Retail Customer's kWh consumption by the appropriate ERPF and is rounded to the nearest cent.
