**ORDER NO. 8  
FINDING APPLICATION AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT, SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE  
DATE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the application of Crystal Clear Water, Inc. for a Class C rate change for service provided in Bosque County. On August 26, 2020, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness and notice and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and sufficient for further review. Additionally, the ALJ finds the notice and affidavit of notice to be sufficient.

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.33(a)(2), the ALJ suspends the effective date of the proposed rate change until August 23, 2021 (which is 265 days from the proposed effective date of December 1, 2020).

The procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted as follows:

Proposed effective date of rate change	December 1, 2020
Deadline to intervene, comment, or request a hearing (90 days from the proposed effective date of December 1, 2020). <sup>1</sup>	March 1, 2021

<sup>1</sup> Under 16 TAC § 24.35(c)(2), if during the first 90 days after the effective date of the rate change, the Commission receives a complaint from any affected municipality, or protests from the lesser of 1,000 or 10% of the ratepayers of the utility over whose rates the Commission has original jurisdiction, the Commission shall set the matter for hearing.

Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on final disposition	March 8, 2021
Deadline for applicant to respond to Commission Staff's recommendation or, if no disputed issues exist, deadline for parties to file proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs.	March 15, 2021
Deadline for the Commission to set the matter for a hearing on its own motion (120th day after the effective date) <sup>2</sup>	March 31, 2021
