COMMISSION STAFF'S PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 8, 2020, Crystal Clear Water, Inc. (Applicants) filed a Class C Rate Change Application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), for service provided in Bosque County under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12997.

On May 13, 2022, the administrative law judge issued Order No. 13, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Commission to file a proposed procedural schedule including deadlines for the Applicants to respond to the remand order and for parties to file an amended proposed order. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.
