## **COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

#### I. INTRODUCTION

On April 8, 2020, Crystal Clear Water, Inc. (Crystal Clear) filed a Class C Rate Change Application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), for service provided in Bosque County under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12997.

On December 1, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 21, directing parties to file an amended proposed order by January 31, 2023.

#### II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), upon request, the time allowed for filing any documents may be extended for good cause. Parties are still negotiating and trying to reach a resolution. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline to file an amended proposed order be extended to February 15, 2023. Staff has conferred with counsel for the Office of Public Interests Counsel and counsel for Crystal Clear and is authorized to represent they support the proposed extension request.

#### **III. CONCLUSION**

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline to file an amended proposed order or provide a status update be extended to February 15, 2023.
