To Whom It May Concern,

We are writing in protest to the "Notice of Proposed Rate Change" for "Crystal Clear Water, Inc. Airport/Whispering" CCN# 0180032/0180081 that we received. The letter is dated April 8th, 2020 and was received by us on April 11th, 2020.

After reading the notice we found that the rate increase amount is unfair and taking advantage of the residents. We believe this because of the following reasons:

- 1. The rate increase is equivalent to a 211.2% increase. This is more than double! We understand the need for a rate increase but for the amount to double in a single increase is criminal.
- 2. The residents have no other choices. Unlike other utilities such as electricity, LP, or cable, we do not have any other options. A rate increase of this magnitude is simply taking advantage of the resident's inability to "shop around" for better service.
- 3. The quality of the service is lacking. Each time the service provider "maintains" the system the water becomes unbearable due to an overwhelming "bleach/chlorine" smell for a couple of weeks. During this period you do not want to drink it and you smell of "bleach/chlorine" after taking a shower. The remainder of the time the water is barely tolerable in taste and we find it is best to either purchase bottled water for drinking or at a minimum filter the water again ourselves before drinking.
- 4. Our location is within a mile or two of the city limits and after checking with various city residents we discovered that their water bill includes trash pickup and totals approximately \$99/mo. We do not have this option and have a separate trash bill that averages approximately \$54/mo. So with the proposed rate increase our water and trash would be approximately \$137/mo. This is 138% higher than what our nearby city residents pay and they have better quality and pressure of water and service.
- 5. The proposed rate increase includes a tier charge scale that increases in cost the more you use. This scale adds a third tier that was not previously there and the rate increase of the second tier is 278.4%. This is an even bigger increase than the more common 1st tier usage indicated above. And with the addition of the third tier, anyone who happens to get billed in this tier would experience a rate increase of 391.5%!
- 6. Quality of service and product do not match the requested rate increase.

We get the potential need for a rate increase but this is just feels like price gouging since we do not have a choice. And right now, with the times we live in, it is as if the provider is taking advantage of the situation and the residents in order to simply make more money.

We hope that you take these things into consideration and at a minimum limit the amount allowed for the rate increase.
