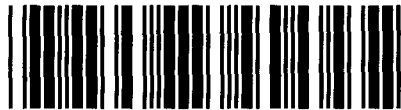

**ORDER NO. 1  
NOTICE REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

This Order addresses AEP Texas Inc.'s April 14, 2020, Interim Rider TC-3 (Transition Charge-3) Rates True Up in compliance with the Financing Order in Docket No. 39931.<sup>1</sup> The Financing Order authorized the issuance of transition bonds for AEP Texas Central Company (now merged into AEP Texas Inc.) for the recovery of stranded costs, carrying costs, and up-front qualified costs associated with such bonds through Rider TC-3.. Schedule TC-3 states that the Commission has 15 days to confirm the accuracy of the adjustments and that any necessary corrections to the adjusted rates will be made in a future true-up adjustment. AEP Texas proposed an effective date with the first billing cycle for April 29, 2020.

The administrative law judge enters the Commission's standard protective order attached to this Order, which governs the use of all confidential and highly confidential documents used in this proceeding.

By April 28, 2020, Commission Staff must file a recommendation regarding the accuracy of the adjustments, the administrative completeness of the application, and the sufficiency of notice.
