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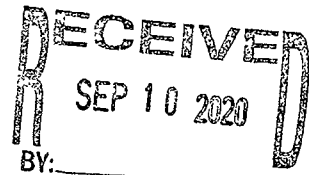

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE WATER UTILITY SERVICE IN NAVARRO COUNTY, TEXAS

The City of Richland has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to obtain a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) for the provision of retail water utility service in Navarro County, Texas.

The requested area is located approximately 10 mile(s) south of downtown Corsicana, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Richland Creek, on the east by Richland Chambers Reservoir and FM 246, on the south by CR 2380, and on the west by SH 111. The total requested area includes approximately 8,608 acres and 282 current customers.

A copy of the map showing the requested area is available at 103 W. Main Street, Richland, TX 76681.

Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 1326, Austin, Texas 78711-1326, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (800) 782-8177. Hearing and speech impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for a final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more that is partially or wholly located within the requested area may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt-out") within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility. All opt-out requests must include a large-scale map, a metrics and bound description of the landowner's tract of land, landowner's name, address, email address and fax number, if applicable.

REQUIRED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and have not reached your 36th birthday
- A high school diploma or G.E.D.
- An applicant for firefighter shall meet the following criteria to be considered for an entry level position. The criteria may be given to applicants who possess certification in the following order:

- 1) Must be certified as a **Structural Firefighter** by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection AND must be certified as an **EMT Paramedic** by the Texas Department of State Health Services
- OR
- 2) Must be certified as an **EMT Paramedic** by the Texas Department of State Health Services
- OR
- 3) Must be certified as a **Structural Firefighter** by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection AND must be certified as a **Firefighter** by the Texas Department of State Health Services

- Applicants must possess (1) EMT Paramedic Certification with Texas Department of State Health Services or (2) Certification as Structural Firefighter with Texas Commission on Fire Protection and Certification for EMT Paramedic or EMT Basic with Texas Department of State Health Services prior to being offered employment with the Corsicana Fire Department
- Applicants must have successfully passed the Hazardous Materials Examination at the EMT Basic or EMT Paramedic level prior to being offered employment with the Corsicana Fire Department

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION AT TIME OF APPLICATION (Passed applications and required documents are accepted)

- Evidence of certification by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection or evidence of current enrollment in a training academy approved by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection
- Evidence of certification by the Texas Department of State Health Services as an EMT Paramedic or EMT Basic or evidence of current enrollment in a class approved by the Texas Department of State Health Services
- Evidence of certification of Hazardous Materials
- Form DD-716 (U.S. Department of Defense) military service record (if applicable) or a letter from the Texas Department of State Health Services (if applicable) showing proof of 700 provided they submit a DD-214 stating an Honorable Discharge
