## COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Commission Staff's Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Proposed Procedural Schedule. Staff recommends that the application is administratively complete. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On April 20, 2020, Val Verde Utility Company, LLC (Val Verde) filed petition under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.249 to decertify the water service area held under its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13179 in Val Verde County. Val Verde stated that no water services have ever been provided after the CCN was initially obtained, and there have never been any customers.

On June 10, 2020, Order No. 1 in this proceeding was issued, requiring Staff to file a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition by July 9, 2020. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

#### II. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed Val Verde's petition and, as detailed in the attached memorandum from Patricia Garcia, Infrastructure Division, recommends that the petition is administratively complete for further processing. Specifically, Staff recommends that the petition properly details the proposed cessation of service, states the reason for the requested action, and includes sufficient

mapping data. Staff additionally recommends that the effective date of the action be determined to be no earlier than August 18, 2020.<sup>1</sup>

#### III. NOTICE

In accordance with Staff's recommendation that the petition is administratively complete, Staff recommends that Val Verde proceed with providing public notice. Specifically, Staff recommends that Val Verde use the attached form titled *Notice to Current Customers*, *Neighboring Systems*, and Cities to provide notice to all required recipients, as detailed in Ms. Garcia's attached memorandum. Additionally, Staff recommends that Val Verde use the attached *Notice for Publication* form to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in Val Verde County once each week for two consecutive weeks beginning the week after the proposed notice is approved by the Commission. Further, Staff recommends that Val Verde file the attached *Affidavit of Notice* and *Publisher 's Affidavit* forms upon completion of notice, as detailed in the proposed procedural schedule below.

IV. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	August 24, 2020
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is provided

#### V. CONCLUSION

Staff recommends that Val Verde's petition be found administratively complete, that Val Verde be directed to provide notice as detailed above and in the attached memorandum, and that the above-proposed procedural schedule be adopted. Staff respectfully requests that an order be issued consistent with the foregoing recommendations.

On April 20, 2020, Val Verde Utility Company, LLC (Petitioner) filed a petition to discontinue water service and cancel certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 13179 in Val Verde County. The Petitioner asserts no utility services have ever been provided in the water service area, which includes approximately 3,103 acres and no customers.

Based on Staff's review of the above referenced petition, Staff recommends that the petition be deemed administratively complete. Staff further recommends the following actions be required of the Petitioner:

- 1) Provide notice of the petition by first-class mail to the following:
  - a. Cities, districts, and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate boundaries or certificated service area are located within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area, including:
    - City of Del Rio
    - Del Rio Utilities Commission
  - b. The county judge of each county that is wholly or partially included in the requested area, including:
    - Val Verde County Judge

Addresses can be obtained by the Petitioner from the Water Utility Database at http://www.puc.texas.gov/watersearch. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's (TCEQ's) web site located at http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/.

- 2) Publish notice in a newspaper having general circulation in the county where the requested area is located, once each week for two consecutive weeks. Proof in the form of a publisher's affidavit must be filed within 30 days of the publication date. The affidavit must state with specificity each county in which the newspaper is of general circulation.
- 3) Provide notice using the attached notice forms.

- 4) Provide an accurate map delineating the requested area, with each individual notice, to neighboring utilities, other affected parties, and landowners.
- 5) File in the docket a signed affidavit specifying every person and entity to whom notice was provided, the date that the notice was provided, and the publisher's affidavit for proof of newspaper publication. Also, file a representative copy of the actual notice and a copy of the map that was included with each individual notice. All documentation must be filed within 30 days of the date of notice. It is recommended that the Petitioner use the attached notice and affidavits to meet these requirements.


