DEFINITIONS

- 1) "EPE," "the Company" or "you" refers to El Paso Electric Company and any person acting or purporting to act on their behalf, including without limitation, attorneys, agents, advisors, investigators, representatives, employees or other persons.

- Staff 1-1 Please provide a detailed breakdown of the administrative, and research and development costs outlined in Exhibit CAE-01, Table 10, at 23 for the 2019 program year. Provide copies of applicable invoices and contracts.
- Staff 1-2 Please provide a detailed breakdown of the research and development costs proposed for the 2020 and 2021 program years outlined in Exhibit CAE-01, Table 6, at 18. Provide copies of any applicable contracts.
- Staff 1-3 Exhibit CAE-01, at 9, states that EPE's Large Commercial and Industrial Solutions Program MTP is offered to commercial customers. However, Exhibit CAE-01, Table 2 at 8 indicates the target audience of the program is large commercial and industrial customers. Please confirm or deny that that EPE makes this program available only to customers in eligible customer classes under 16 Tex. Admin Code § 25.181(a).
- **Staff 1-4** Explain the difference between EPE's projected kW savings from its Commercial Load Management Program and its reported and verified kW savings in 2019.
