



COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION TO AMEND THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On May 18, 2020, Manville Water Supply Corporation (Manville WSC) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11144 in Lee and Williamson Counties. The requested service area consists of 9,322 acres and 54 customer connections. The Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) is reviewing Manville WSC's response to Staff's second request for information (RFI). Based on Staff's initial review of the response, Staff tentatively believes that Manville WSC has not shown a need for service for the whole requested area.

On January 27, 2021, Order No. 6 was filed, which established a deadline of March 1, 2021 for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Manville WSC for review and consent. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff requests additional time to review Manville WSC's response to Staff's second RFI and to work with Manville WSC on a possible reduction to the requested area such that it excludes area where there is no need for service. Therefore, Staff proposes the following amended procedural schedule.

Deadline for Manville WSC to amend its application and provide amended maps	April 12, 2021	
Deadline for Staff to file comments on the sufficiency of Manville WSC's amended application and amended maps and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of the docket	April 30, 2021	

Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Manville WSC for review and consent	April 15, 2021
Deadline for Manville WSC to file its signed consent form with the Commission	April 29, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	May 6, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	May 13, 2021

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests that the proposed procedural schedule be adopted.
