**ORDER NO. 9
FINDING REVISED MAPPING SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the revised mapping and digital data to supplement the application by Manville Water Supply Corporation (Manville WSC) to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity number 11144 in Williamson and Lee counties, and establishes a procedural schedule. On April 22, 2021, Manville WSC filed revised mapping and digital data to reduce the size of the requested area to approximately 3,414.5 acres.

On May 21, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of revised mapping.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the revised mapping sufficient. Additionally, the ALJ finds the original notice provided by Manville WSC remains sufficient and no further notice is required.

The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule for further processing of the application:

Event	Date
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Manville WSC for review and consent	June 25, 2021
Deadline for Manville WSC to file its signed consent form with the Commission	July 9, 2021
Deadline to request a hearing; if no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	July 23, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	August 6, 2021
