COMMENTS/ATTACHMENT TO PROPOSED RATE INCREASE SUBMITTED BY MONARCH UTILITIES

PROTEST:

- (1). Due to the COVID 19 pandemic many Monarch Utilities customers are currently unemployed and/or strugling financially. It is absured that this company would even consider a rate increase during these times.
- (2). Monarch Utilities claim that water/waste water utilities are the most expensive utilities to build and maintain in compatison to other essential utilities is a false claim. It is true however, that customers are currently paying more for this service than any other utility service. Which is also absured and unreasonable.
- (3). Monarch Utilities claims to have invested \$35.1 million dollars over the past four years on system upgrades and un-seen infrastructure. But provides no documentation or evidence in support of this claim to their customers. In my opinion the reason this alleged infrastructure is "Un-Seen". Is because it is non-existent. As well, the need for futher upgrades and/or infrastructure is non-existent if the current service provided is as reliable as stated. All necessary water/waste water pipes, treatment plants and the like are currently installed and operational with the exception of a rare pipe breakage or mechanical repairs. Once again, the need for further upgrades or infrastructure building is unnecessary.
- (4). The current tariff rates are excessively, outrageously too expensive. A rate increase of 3.92% for water. And a rate increase of 6.59% for waste water or any other percentage is TOTALLY unacceptable.
