**SETTING DEADLINE TO RESPOND TO COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION**  
**FOR SUMMARY DECISION**

On August 18, 2020, Commission Staff filed its second supplemental statement of position and a motion for summary decision. Commission Staff asserts that Mr. Collins' complaint is appropriate for disposition by summary decision because there is no genuine issue as to any material fact. Accordingly, Commission Staff requests that the administrative law judge (ALJ) grant its motion for summary decision under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.182(a).

Mr. Collins must file his response to Commission Staff's motion for summary decision by September 7, 2020.<sup>1</sup> Mr. Collins must show, by affidavits, materials obtained by discovery or otherwise, admissions, matters officially noticed, or evidence of record, that there is a genuine issue of material fact or that summary decision is inappropriate as a matter of law.
