RESPONSE TO COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY

DECISION

DISCLAMER;

The Complaintant is acting Pro-Se and is not a legal attorney. Therefore He can not be held to the same standards of law as a legal attorney would be in this response.

The Commission Staff's Motion For Summary Decision is without merit and inappropriate as a mater of law and should not granted for the following reasons;

- (1). The commission based it's reason of denial of complaintant's formal complaint on the issue of a water pass through charge being collected by Monarch Utilities. The issue of this water pass through charge is a side bar issue raised by the commission staff itself. The complaintant did **NOT** raise this issue in his Formal Complaint. Therefore this issue is not relevant to the instant case. And cannot be a reason for denial.
- (2). The Complaintant's Formal Complaint was submitted against the Public Utilities Commission itself in addition to Southwest/Monarch Utilities I.L.P. **None** of the issues raised against the Public Utilities Commission were addressed in response to the complaintant's formal complaint. Please refer to attachment (Complaint's Formal Complaint)
- (3). The commission has failed to address the issue of Southwest/Monarch Utilities being a private investor owned company rather than a Non-Profit corporation as defined by code 49.001(a)(5), TWC 31.002(g)(24) and TWC 13.004(a)(2). The commission, in addition to Monarch Utilities, has failed to provide ANY Rule of Law which allows a private investor owned water/waste water company to be granted a tariff priviledge and/or to operate as a public utilities provider within the State of Texas.
- (4). The complaintant provided the commission with documentation (See Attachment) proving


that CCN Number 20899, application number 34102-C, is assigned to Tecon Water Company and NOT to Monarch Utilities I,L.P. This issue has not been addressed by the commission in any manner whatsoever.

- (5). The Complaintant raised the issue of a violation of His Constitutional Rights under Texas Constitution Article 1 Sec. 3. The commission acknowledged this complaint but failed to fully address this issue.
- (6). The Complaintant alleged in His formal complaint that Southwest/Monarch Utilities is committing the criminal act of Extortion which is being **Allowed** by the commission under the banner of a approved tariff. The Commission has acknowledged this allegation but has failed to address this issue.
