



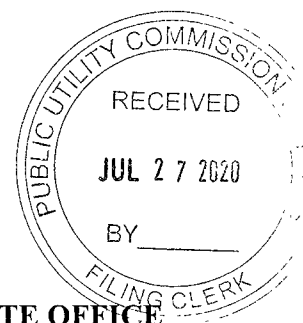

SOAH ORDER NO. 4
GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE AND REMAND, AND
DISMISSING CASE FROM THE SOAH DOCKET

On July 20, 2020, Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC (Oncor) filed a Joint Motion to Admit Evidence and Remand this Docket (Joint Motion) to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) on behalf of itself, Commission Staff, the Steering Committee of Cities Served by Oncor (Cities), and the Alliance for Retail Markets (collectively, the Parties). Oncor states that the Parties executed a Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (Settlement) on July 20, 2020, which includes a Proposed Order that resolves all issues in this proceeding. The Settlement is included as Attachment A to the Joint Motion. Exhibit 1 to the Settlement is Rider EECRF – Energy Efficiency Cost Recovery Factor. Exhibit 2 to the Settlement is the Proposed Order. The Parties request admission of evidence supporting the Settlement into the record, dismissal of this proceeding from the State Office of Administrative Hearings’ docket, and remand to the Commission for consideration and approval.

As presented in the Joint Motion, the following exhibits are **ADMITTED** into the record in this docket:
