COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On June 1, 2020, Champs Water Company (Champs) and Midway Water Utilities, Inc. (Midway) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris and Montgomery Counties. Midway seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of Champs’ water and sewer service area under Champs’ water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) numbers 10972 and sewer CCN 20385 to Midway’s water CNN number 10972 and sewer CNN number 20385. On August 3, 2020, August 4, 2020, August 10, 2020, and August 18, 2020, Applicants filed supplements to the application.

On May 3, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 10, establishing a deadline of May 10, 2021 for Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs to the applicants for review and consent. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

At this time, Staff requires additional time to draft and finalize final maps, certificates, and tariffs for the Applicants. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ extend the deadlines for Staff to provide the final maps, certificates, and tariffs to the Applicants for review and consent, as well as all subsequent deadlines.

II. PROPOSED AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following amended procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to applicants for review and consent	June 4, 2021
Deadline for applicants to file signed consent forms with the Commission	June 11, 2021
Deadline for parties to jointly file a proposed notice of approval, including proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law and ordering paragraphs	June 18, 2021

III. CONCLUSION

Based on the preceding considerations, Staff respectfully requests that an order be issued adopting the amended proposed procedural schedule.
